Under a 201 commitment, <u>YOU</u> have more rights and more control of the length of your hospital stay. For example, with a written notice, <u>YOU</u> can request your discharge date. On the other hand, <u>YOU</u> can extend your in-patient stay for as long as you and/or the medical staff believe that there is a continued need for treatment.

PRIVACY

- Your Protected Health Information (PHI) is confidential and protected under HIPAA and Pennsylvania regulations.
- Under a 201 commitment, no information is submitted to the PA State Police regarding your psychiatric admission or treatment.

A VOLUNTARY COMMITTMENT (a "201) IS DRAMA FREE

- No police.
- No restraints.
- No required hearings during the admission process.
