



Guiding Principles

- **Culturally and Linguistically Competent**
 - SOC agencies, programs, and services are responsive to the cultural, racial, and ethnic differences of the populations they serve.
- **Community Based**
 - This model doesn't put the system at the center but rather the people and communities involved in the system.
- **Family Focused**
 - The SOC is not just concentrated on the individual but rather both the individual and those surrounding and supporting the individual.
- **Peer Centered**
 - The SOC focuses on helping each individual achieve the most satisfying life possible.
- **Trauma Informed**
 - Because the SOC is working to increase awareness of trauma and to build a workforce capable of providing trauma informed care.
- **Data Driven**
 - The SOC is based on a proven model by Drs. Minkoff and Cline. The BCBH SOC uses research and data to improve care and plan next steps.
- **Recovery and Resiliency Based**
 - The goal of the SOC is to put individual and families in the middle of the conversation and build services and supports around their vision for a happy, meaningful life.
